

EPIDERMAL GROWTH FACTOR KIT

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

It's important to maintain an aseptic work area when initially handling the sterile dropper bottle parts & EGF powder. Use the sterile gloves provided to handle the sterile dropper bottle spout, and when mixing the EGF powder. Open the sterile glove pack, use the paper they are wrapped in to set your materials on. Disassemble the sterile dropper bottle. Open the vile of EGF powder then gently pour the vile of EGF powder into the empty sterile dropper bottle. Open the saline vile then gently squeeze it into the sterile dropper bottle with the EGF powder. Fill the bottle to the collar/corner only. **Don't** fill it to the very brim of the bottle opening. Discard the vile of leftover saline solution. Replace the spout and the cap on the dropper bottle. Now gently invert the bottle to mix the EGF powder and saline solution. Inversion is enough to mix the powder, you do not want to damage the delicate EGF cells. After the EGF powder has completely dissolved, squeeze a few drops into the original EGF vile, replace the top then gently invert the bottle to get the remaining EGF powder residue to dissolve. Afterward, pour that solution into the dropper bottle. Replace the dropper spout & top. Your EGF solution is now ready to use.

USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

You can apply this EGF solution directly to cuts, scrapes, bruises, sunburns, acne, burns, and open wounds in order to heal your skin rapidly and prevent scarring & hyperpigmentation. You can also add your EGF solution to your anti-aging creams and skin whitening creams to further beautify your skin. Start by adding 10 drops per 4fl.oz of cream. The amount you add is up to you, if you feel you want more activity then add more EGF solution to your skin cream/serum. An EGF solution is excellent for quickly healing minor skin injuries like scrapes, scratches, and bruises. But EGF is also excellent in rapidly healing your skin after major skin injuries like deep micro-needling; surgery; lip injections; Botox injections; CO2 laser resurfacing; laser/wax hair removal; or after any procedure that causes moderate to severe skin trauma. If you're new to EGF please do further research on the benefits of using EGF in skin care.

IMPORTANT

Only use the sterile EGF solution in the dropper bottle to heal open wounds. After the wound closes you may proceed with using your formulated EGF skin cream to further heal the wound and prevent scarring & hyperpigmentation.
